

# AMNIOTIC GRAFTS – WHO QUALIFIES?

Per Medicare Wounds That Qualify Must Have The Following Qualifications:



If a patient has used Medicare Part A, they have to wait 100 days before they can use Medicare Part B to get help for chronic wounds.



1

Partial- or full-thickness ulcers, not involving tendon, muscle, joint capsule or exhibiting exposed bone or sinus tracts, with a clean granular base

2

Skin deficit at least 1.0 square centimeter (cm) in size

3

Clean and free of necrotic debris or exudate

4

Have adequate circulation/oxygenation to support tissue growth//wound healing as evidenced by physical examination (e.g., Ankle-Brachial Index [ABI] of no less than 0.60, toe pressure greater than 30 millimetres of mercury [mmHg])

5

For diabetic foot ulcers, the patient's medical record reflects a diagnosis of Type 1 or Type 2 Diabetes and also reflects medical management for this condition.
